WCCA Meeting Minutes September 21, 2016

President Ron Gray called the meeting to order at 7:35 pm at the Milwaukee Casting Club. The meeting was sponsored by the Women's Hunting and Sporting Association, who provided the refreshments. The meeting was attended by 17 individuals, comprised of club delegates and the Wisconsin Conservation Congress.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

The minutes of the August meeting were accepted as published.

 - The Brookfield Central Trap Shooting Team returned information per request on what they were looking at. More information is in Old Business.
 - NRB is meeting in Black River Falls 9/27-9/28.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

- Wisconsin Conservation Congress
 - o Mark
 - Attended the Rules and Regulations for the Congress on 9/14. What does Youth mean?: 18 years or younger of age OR in high school. Developing outline for grievance process, and Article 17.0 deals with state statutes put in the Congress to follow protocol.
 - Congress is looking at online voting as there is disenfranchisement of working people who can't make the hearings.
 - Muskies are being stocked in Pewaukee and Okauchee Lakes. DNR is stocking northern in Pewaukee Lake; walleyes elsewhere.
 - - The trout resolution regarding bait, keeping fish and opening bodies of water has been rejected as there are four resolutions in one.
 - o Al –

- Between 2005 and 2010, it's estimated 25 times more caught and released than kept. There
 are more muskies in Pewaukee than anywhere in the state. As a note, walleyes are stocked to
 prey on the perch.
- Banquet
 - We need an inside track on advertising to get the message out.
 - o How do you get more people to come? Do you give away tables?
 - o Tickets and the flyer will be printed. Tickets will be \$50.
- Kids Fishing Clinic
 - o Waukesha County parks, the reservations are in. Which clubs are returning?
