- Check your hunting seasons, permits. Zone 2 had 1,000 turkey permits available. Please check your regulations!
- DNR Wardens in State Parks (as rangers) An epiphany occurred and now the DNR is trying to get rangers accredited again. One law enforcement group does not work.
- Outdoor News shoot was advertised.
- Waukesha County has a new biologist, Nathan Holoubuek, who is now on the invite list for meetings.
- Scholarship recipient, Jordan Schuler, sent a thank you letter to the Alliance.

  - Tom Daluga
    - The warm water and upload game committee had 25 resolutions and ½ advanced. To note, some of the resolutions include musky/trophy lakes dropping size limits and a few things on bass.
    - Upland committee meeting is upcoming.
  - Al Shook
    - Spring Hearings "Advisory" vote, and will be online this coming sprint. Delegate election will still be in person.
    - District Meeting 8/14 notes 2% decrease in wolf population (905-944)
    - Migratory birds the North/South zone will start September 29; the Horicon zone has been eliminated; Canadian goose limits will be 3/day, and the southern zone will close 12/3 and reopen on 12/16 through to 1/3; ruffled grouse population low, maybe due to West Nile virus?

- Elk none from Kentucky this year, 46 next year.
- CWD 600+ out of 9,800 in Okauzee County and taking a closer look. There will be travel restrictions this year with a carcass from a CWD zone. Congress proposing a "kit" of sorts to provide send-in test kit.
- 27 warden vacancies, only money for 5.
