Tom Daluga responded that someone in a county requested a ban on lead and the committee considered it to be something the people should decide on, as it came from the people. It would exclude ammunition used in target shooting. MarySusan Diedrich, on the Rules and Regulations committee, can determine county by county votes, and will bring the information to the next meeting or contact Paul directly. It was stated, generally, online voting can distort opinions.
